# **RAMANUJAN COLLEGE**

Ramanujan College is a constituent College of the University of Delhi (DU). It is inspired by the life and work of Srinivasa Aiyangar Ramanujan, one of the world's greatest mathematicians. The College has been accredited Grade "A" by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in its First Cycle. It is located in the well-known area of Kalkaji, near Nehru Place, in South Delhi.

The College was established in 1958 as an evening college for boys with just five programmes. Since 2010, Ramanujan College has been expanding and now with the latest addition of B.Sc. Environmental Sciences (Hons) in 2020, it at present offers sixteen undergraduate programmes in different disciplines. This achievement, in alignment to the recommendations of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, makes the College a centre for interdisciplinary studies and research with a future focus on blended learning. It has gradually grown into a self-sufficient and self-reliant institution owing to its academic vigour and intellectual capital.

Ramanujan College was awarded the Deen Dayal Upadhyay – Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood (DDU KAUSHAL) Kendra in 2016 by the UGC, under which two vocational courses were started in Banking Operations and Software Development.

The College has conducted a Course on Human Rights, Environment and Ethics through its National Resource Centre (NRC), under the Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT) scheme of Ministry of Education (MoE). This Course was uploaded on MoE's Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) platform SWAYAM and many participants registered for it.

Ramanujan College offers various short-term diploma, certificate, and executive development programmes on contemporary and skilloriented themes. These are conceived and designed by faculty members in consultation with external experts. The courses get exceptional response from the students and are conducted throughout the academic session. They are open to alumni and students of all the colleges. Some of these courses support the curriculum, some prepare the students for higher studies and also accelerate the professional growth.

The College is the Study Centre of School of Open Learning (SOL), Non-Collegiate Women Education Board (NCWEB) and Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) for various courses. As an initiative towards students and teachers exchange programmes, the College has entered into Memorandum of Understanding(s) with foreign universities. It is also working for collaboration with other higher education institutions located in remote areas of the country, under the Vidya Vistar Scheme of the University of Delhi.

The prestigious Teaching Learning Centre was awarded to Ramanujan College in 2017 by the Ministry of Education, under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme.

# TEACHING LEARNING CENTRE, RAMANUJAN COLLEGE

Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) is mandated by the Ministry of Education (MoE) to organise Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), Faculty Orientation and Induction Programmes (FIPs), discipline specific and interdisciplinary Refresher Courses, conferences, workshops, through offline and online modes. These programmes are based on indepth subject knowledge, quantitative and qualitative research methodologies, and on an interdisciplinary approach as is envisaged in the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020.

The TLC, Ramanujan College has been set up with the aim of "Reaching the Unreached" teachers in terms of regional diversity and geographically remote areas of the country. It has successfully conducted more than hundred learner-centric programmes since October 2017 and trained over one lakh teachers across the country in various discipline specific and interdisciplinary programmes.

In the TLC Programmes distinguished and internationally acclaimed resource persons deliver lectures and conduct sessions on wide ranging disciplines/topics of relevance in the contemporary and ever evolving global scenario to benefit the teaching fraternity, corporates and researchers. The sessions are also uploaded for larger audiences on the official YouTube Channel of the College.

Ramanujan College is a pioneer in offering offline/online courses for faculty members of higher education institutions and research scholars through the customised Learning Management System (LMS), designed by the College's Research Development and Services Cell. It is predominantly participant-friendly and incorporates evaluation methods and comprehensive feedback systems to judge learning outcomes. The LMS is hosted on CLOUD with high scalability and reliability. The College has installed its own Cloud Infrastructure to host its servers for research and data analysis.

Research Department in our college named as M.Phil and Research Department. M.Phil. in Education Course was introduced in our college in 1981.The Research Department in our college was established in the year 1943. Our research department has contributed a lot in the field of education. The research centre got recognition from Savitribai Phule Pune University. The college conducts M.Phil (Education) and Ph.D (Education) courses affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University.

#### **M.Phil (Education)**

The intake capacity for M.Phil course is 20 students. M.Ed qualified ( minimum55%) can seek the admission for this course. Duration of the course is 18 months. The admission procedure and declaration of degree is governed by the Savitribai Phule Pune University. In the year 2007 M.Phil (Education) course of YCMOU, Nasik were conducted and coordinated by Dr. Depal Chavan under the guidance of ex-principal Dr. Nandini Patil. From the year 2011 M.Phil (Education) course of Savitribai Phule Pune University was started.

#### PhD (Education)

11 faculty members of our college have completed their Ph.D. and 3 have registered for Ph.D. in the research centre. Savitribai Phule Pune University adopted centralized admission process for Ph.D. through Ph.D. Entrance Examination (PET). Through this process near about 80 students have registered in our research centre for Ph.D.



# DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, ASSAM UNIVERSITY

Department of Education, Ashutosh Mukhopadhyay School of Educational Sciences, Assam University, Silchar, was established in the year 1995. It is named after one of the most emphatic figures of Indian Education system. The department since its inception has been interdisciplinary in its endeavor. As an academic field of study, the Department of Education is primarily engaged in the pursuit of analyzing and exploring the diverse teaching methodologies required for different layers of education (primary, secondary, and higher). As a branch of study, it is also concerned with developing pedagogical knowledge, providing input for educational policy, imparting training program for the stakeholders in the field.

Two-year M.A. program equips the learner with content knowledge and prepares them for the job market. It also has an open choice paper entitled 'HUMAN RIGHTS AND PEACE EDUCATION' which aims to create awareness about educational rights. M.Ed. on the other hand is more a field-oriented course which is intrinsically concerned with developing teaching professionals, educational planners, counselors and educational entrepreneurs.

One of the major highlights of this course is to bring out educational administrators and content experts. One of the salient features of the department is its four-year integrated B.Sc. B.Ed. program offering honors in Chemistry, Physics, Zoology, and Botany with emphasis on pedagogical indoctrination. This is a state-of-the-art course aimed at equipping the youths with skills and competencies of teaching at secondary level. Besides these programs, the department is also credited with a center for educational planning and management which offers Diploma in educational Planning and management and conducts in-service training program and workshops in collaboration with national level organizations. In a nutshell, the Department of Education of Assam University is committed to bring out desired changes in the teaching-learning process throughout the region through its research input, innovative pedagogy and student outreach program. With the flagship programme of the Ministry of Education PMMMNMTT. Under PMMMNMTT, Training programmes are being offered to Primary and Secondary Teachers, Educational Administrators and different other stakeholders. Through the Centre for Educational Planning and Management diverse training programmes have been conducted so far.

These courses aim at sensitizing the newly inducted learners and teachers about the very idea of being an academic apart from equipping them with an understanding of their roles and responsibilities in an educational institution. It orients them about the idea of being a teacher/academic and the integral aspects of the teaching-learning process, innovative methods and methodologies, pedagogical concerns, evaluation-assessment methods, techniques, and ICT enabled methods of learning/ dissemination apart from inculcating research acumen amongst participants.

A common theme running throughout the courses have been understanding the nuances of Indian Education System in the wake of newly introduced NEP, its implications, challenges, and way ahead. One of the other core facets is to make them well versed with the rule and regulations about the basics of governance and administration at different levels of Education. From critical teaching issues to classroom spaces, students' to that of one's own professional growth and development, from pedagogical engagement to structural challenges, from institutional vision to educational policies to national development, the program envisions to train the newly inducted learners and teachers with an holistic development approach at its center.

### CENTRE FOR EDUCATIONAL PLANNING & MANAGEMENT A.M. SCHOOL OF EDUCATIONAL SCIENCES

The Department of Education started with a Master's degree programme in Education in July 1995. In addition, the department offers M.Phil. and Ph.D. programmes from the year 1998. The department began offering M.Ed. in 2007 and a four-year integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. programme in 2012. The department added another feather to its crown by introducing the Centre for Educational Planning and Management in July 2011 to satisfy the requirements of the modern age by offering Master's degree course in Educational Planning and Management (MEPM) and Post Graduate Diploma in Educational Planning and Management (PGDEPM).

The Centre for Educational Planning and Management offers oneyear Diploma course (2 semesters) that can be continued for another year to earn a Postgraduate degree (4 semesters) with a capacity of 25 students. Also, the Centre for Educational Planning and Management offers training for students, in-service teachers, preprincipals, social teachers, workers, educational service administrators, and other personnel working in schools, colleges, and universities, including deemed universities, particularly in the North Region. The Centre for Educational Planning and Eastern Management also intends to equip the learners to traverse the predicament through their reflective and critical approach.

The Centre has organised one 21-day training programme and 03 National Webinars so far.

The Centre for Educational Planning and Management is one of the significant wings of the Department of Education. As the sector of Education is witnessing drastic changes due to changing social and technological revolution, it is utmost important to prepare the human resources to run the system diligently. India's Education system is going through a paradigmatic shift with the culmination of virtual **Refresher Course** 

learning along with face-to-face mode of learning. The NEP 2020 has also envisioned the paramount importance of Teaching, Pedagogy and its amalgamation with the contents of diverse disciplines. It also resonates the need for preparing Educational Leaders for designing and reconstructing the field of Education to mitigate the vacuum between academic degrees and the requirements of the job market. Therefore, the Centre for Educational Planning and Management reinvigorates its pledge to prepare future visionaries and Instructional Designers who can globally establish themselves through their pedagogical acumen. It adheres to orient the stakeholders in Education about the idea of being a teacher / academic and the integral aspects of the teaching-learning process, innovative methods and methodologies, pedagogical concerns, evaluation-assessment methods, techniques, and ICT enabled methods of learning / dissemination apart from inculcating a research insight amongst the learners.

# **CONCEPT NOTE**

The importance of quality schooling and meaningful teachinglearning encounters for the all- round development of a child. The policy envisions to make holistic and multidisciplinary education to bring skilled personnel in the nation development. School Education needs to be strengthened through structural reforms in regulatory system so that we can give level playing field to all learners. NEP aims to provide better opportunities to those who wish to become multitalented, skillful teachers through quality teacher education.

In this context, this Refresher Course is chalked out for the overall quality enhancement of teacher educators, both as a teacher educator and as a researcher. The programme will to sensitize the participants with the latest developments in the fields of pedagogy of teaching, curriculum transaction, evaluation strategies, research and academic writing without undermining the importance of personality and skill development of the teacher educators.
