Ramanujan College, a constituent College of the University of Delhi was established in 1958 as an evening college. The College has been accredited Grade "A++" by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in its Second Cycle. At present, Ramanujan College offers sixteen undergraduate programmes in different disciplines. The College has been awarded the DDU KAUSHAL (Deen Dayal Upadhyay – Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood) Kendra (2016) by UGC and Teaching Learning Centre (2017) by the Ministry of Education. The College also offers short-term diploma, certificate, and executive development programmes on contemporary & skill – oriented themes to complement the regular graduation courses.

It is also the Study Centre of Non-Collegiate Women Education Board (NCWEB) and Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) for various courses. In 2018, the College conducted a Course on Human Rights, Environment and Ethics through its National Resource Centre (NRC), under the Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT) scheme of MoE.

The College has also entered into Memorandum of Understanding(s) with foreign universities. It is also working for collaboration with other higher education institutions located in remote areas of the country, under the Vidya Vistar Scheme of the University of Delhi.



TEACHING LEARNING CENTRE RAMANUJAN COLLEGE

Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) is mandated by the Ministry of Education (MoE) to organise Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), Faculty Orientation and Induction Programmes (FIPs), discipline specific and interdisciplinary Refresher Courses, conferences, workshops, through offline and online modes. These programmes are based on indepth subject knowledge, quantitative and qualitative research methodologies, and on an interdisciplinary approach as is envisaged in the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020.

The TLC, Ramanujan College has been set up with the aim of "Reaching the Unreached" teachers in terms of regional diversity and geographically remote areas of the country. It has successfully conducted more than hundred learner-centric programmes since October 2017 and trained over one lakh teachers across the country in various discipline specific and interdisciplinary programmes.

The courses are offered through the customised Learning Management System (LMS), designed by the College's Research Development and Services Cell. It is predominantly participant-friendly and incorporates evaluation methods and comprehensive feedback systems to judge learning outcomes. The LMS is hosted on CLOUD with high scalability and reliability. The College has installed its own Cloud Infrastructure to host its servers for research and data analysis.

In the TLC Programmes distinguished and internationally acclaimed resource persons deliver lectures and conduct sessions on wide ranging disciplines/topics of relevance in the contemporary and ever evolving global scenario to benefit the teaching fraternity, corporates and researchers. The sessions are also uploaded for larger audiences on the official <u>YouTube Channel of the College.</u>

SRI SARADA COLLEGE FOR WOMEN (AUTONOMOUS)

Sri Sarada College was started in 1961 as an affiliated college to the University of Madras with two sections of Pre-University class (with eighty students). Later, it has increased in strength to become a First Grade college with twelve under-graduate courses, seven post-graduate courses, nine M.Phil. programmes, nine Ph.D. programmes and two Self - Financing P.G. Courses (M.Sc. Computer Science and M.Com.). Autonomous status was conferred by the University Grants Commission in the year 1988-1989 under the able guidance of Yatiswari Saradapriya Amba. The College was re-accredited with 'B++' Grade by NAAC in the fourth cycle. The foundation stone of Sri Sarada College for women was laid by Former President of India, Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan.

The College offers upto-date career oriented education which is integrated with our ancient culture and tradition. To meet the challenges of the everchanging modern scenario, the academic needs of the young students are closely analyzed and the curriculum is periodically redesigned in a way to develop the scientific temper and to enkindle the spirit of creativity in the students' minds. In almost all disciplines, priority is given to relate curriculum to the local needs. Extensive efforts are taken to concretize the aims and goals of the college through curricular, co-curricular and extension activities.

CONCEPT NOTE

Mathematical Sciences as a subject area have witnessed significant growth in terms of research and applications. The discipline has touched a wide array of activities and processes, ranging from the basic internet search to more complex aspects of computer simulations and digital communication. The cross – disciplinary nature of Mathematical Science has helped it in becoming an integral tool for research in many disciplines, medical science, science & engineering, climate studies, information technology, social science among many others. However, there is a gap between this expansion and the way the subject is generally conceived by its practitioners.

It is in this backdrop, the Teaching Learning Centre, Ramanujan College is offering a Two-week Refresher Course/Faculty Development Programme to acquaint the participants with the skills and knowledge required to further the cross – disciplinary nature of the field and apply it beyond their own area of expertise.
