RAMANUJAN COLLEGE

Ramanujan College, a constituent College of the University of Delhi was established in 1958 as an evening college. The College has been accredited Grade "A++" by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in its Second Cycle.

At present, Ramanujan College offers sixteen undergraduate programmes in different disciplines. Besides this, the college has been awarded the DDU KAUSHAL (Deen Dayal Upadhyay - Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood) Kendra (2016) by UGC and Teaching Learning Centre (2017) by the Ministry of Education. The College also offers short-term diploma, certificate, and executive development programmes on contemporary and skill-oriented themes to complement the regular graduation courses. It is also the Study Centre of School of Open Learning (SOL), Non-Collegiate Women Education Board (NCWEB) and Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) for various courses.

In 2018, the College conducted a Course on Human Rights, Environment and Ethics through its National Resource Centre (NRC), under the Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT) scheme of MoE. The College has also entered into Memorandum of Understanding(s) with foreign universities. It is also working for collaboration with other higher education institutions located in remote areas of the country, under the Vidya Vistar Scheme of the

Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) is mandated by the Ministry of Education (MoE) to organise Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), Faculty Orientation and Induction Programmes (FIPs), discipline specific and interdisciplinary Refresher Courses, conferences, workshops, through offline and online modes. These programmes are based on indepth subject knowledge, quantitative and qualitative research methodologies, and on an interdisciplinary approach as is envisaged in the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020.

The TLC, Ramanujan College has been set up with the aim of "Reaching the Unreached" teachers in terms of regional diversity and geographically remote areas of the country. It has successfully conducted more than hundred learner-centric programmes since October 2017 and trained over one lakh teachers across the country in various discipline specific and interdisciplinary programmes.

In the TLC Programmes distinguished and internationally acclaimed resource persons deliver lectures and conduct sessions on wide ranging disciplines/topics of relevance in the contemporary and ever evolving global scenario to benefit the teaching fraternity, corporates and researchers. The sessions are also uploaded for larger audiences on the official YouTube Channel of the College.

Ramanujan College is a pioneer in offering offline/online courses for faculty members of higher education institutions and research scholars through the customised Learning Management System (LMS), designed by the College's Research Development and Services Cell. It is predominantly participant-friendly and incorporates evaluation methods and comprehensive feedback systems to judge learning outcomes. The LMS is hosted on CLOUD with high scalability and reliability. The College has installed its own Cloud Infrastructure to host its servers for research and data analysis

The college is named after the country's prominent freedom fighter, great administrator and the recipient of the Bharat Ratna— Sh. Govind Ballabh Pant, and is duly affiliated to Himachal Pradesh University (Shimla). This college came into existence in July, 1959 but was formally inaugurated on 11th November, 1959 by Raja Bajrang Bahadur Singh of Bhadri estate, the then lieutenant Governor of Himachal Pradesh. Situated on the left bank of the river Satluj, the college is on the national highway no. 5 and at a distance of about 130 km from the historical town of Shimla, the capital city of Himachal Pradesh.

The college is a co-educational institution and imparts meaningful education in the faculties of Humanities, Science, Commerce, Vocation, Computer Applications. After its inception in undergraduate programmes, the year 1994 marked its new phase of academic development with the opening of Postgraduate classes in the subject of Hindi, English, Commerce, History, Economics, and Political Science. In the year 2017, the new PG courses in the subject of Sociology, Geography, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Physics and Mathematics were introduced. The self- finance course of Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) was started in the academic session 2010-11, based on the feedback of the stakeholders. The skill-oriented Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) was added to the programmes of the college in the year 2017. The primary objective for the implementation of these courses is to empower the youth with practical knowledge that will lead to quality employment and income generating opportunities.

The college campus has a green cover of trees, a sprawling playground and a well-equipped auditorium that provide a healthy ambience for the holistic growth of the students beyond their classrooms. It is surrounded by the scenic beauty of hills that provides the students with ample green space to learn and interact in a lively fresh environment.

With modern laboratories and a library, the learning experience of the students become extensive and practical. There are three girls' hostels and one boys' hostel which make the college an ideal centre for learning and knowledge. The physical infrastructural facilities in the college have expanded over the years to meet the new demands and also to provide better learning environment to the students. A new Science Block with modern amenities will soon become functional. The institution provides a judicious amalgamation of academics, sports, extra-curricular activities and extension activities for the development of mental and physical prowess of the students. The students are motivated to follow the motto of the college that focuses on the knowledge that leads to self-realisation and liberation.

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has awarded grade 'B' to the college for providing quality Higher Education to the students. The college has experienced and qualified teachers who are fully committed to guide and support the students to achieve new academic heights and acquire new skills. The institution draws its strength from the combined efforts of its staff, students and other stakeholders to excel in academics, in extra-curricular activities and in administration.



CONCEPT NOTE

India's National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) makes a paradigm shift in conceptualizing education as a means to equip students with skills suited for the 21st century and not just for making them employable. It calls for deep rethinking and redesigning of academic systems along with parallel changes in administrative and regulatory systems. When done with participation of all concerned – institutional leadership, faculty, administrators, and students– the policy has the potential to align the goals of quality with affordability; academic degrees with job readiness; and national ambitions with individual gains.
