These programmes are based on indepth subject knowledge, quantitative and qualitative research methodologies, and on an interdisciplinary approach as is envisaged in the National Education Policy (NEP), 2020.



The TLC, Ramanujan College has been set up with the aim of "Reaching the Unreached" teachers in terms of regional diversity and geographically remote areas of the country. It has successfully conducted more than hundred learner-centric programmes since October 2017 and trained over one lakh teachers across the country in various discipline specific and interdisciplinary programmes.

Ramanujan College is a pioneer in offering offline/online courses for faculty members of higher education institutions and research scholars through the customised Learning Management System (LMS), designed by the College's Research Development and Services Cell. Har Ghar Dhyan is a collaborative initiative of The Art of Living and Ministry of Culture, Government Of India, under the aegis of "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" (AKAM), as a special offering to benefit the citizens on the occasion of 75 years of independence for our Country.

The Art of Living (TOAL) is a charitable trust, transforming urban & rural India by conducting a broad range of service projects to uplift & empower Individuals, Families & Communities. The Har Ghar Dhyan initiative works through TAOL volunteers, who are aware of the benefits of Meditation, to reach out to the society and encourage people to experience Meditation. Their volunteers or Meditation Ambassadors organize sessions to educate about mental health and meditation. These sessions are being conducted by Trained Art of Living Teachers or Meditation Coaches.



Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) on Knowledge Partnership was signed between TAOL & University of Delhi on 3rd March, 2023 and Prof. Ajay Kumar Singh, Head, Department of Commerce, DU, has been appointed as Nodal Officer for imparting various programs with TOAL to develop skill and capacities of Students, Teaching and Non-Teaching staff towards health & well-being at the University of Delhi. He & his team have been instrumental in coordinating between TAOL & various colleges of DU, in appointing Nodal Officers of Har Ghar Dhyan Committee in these college & in facilitating the organization of Introductory Seminars & Sessions, Youth Empowerment Skill Programs (YES!+) & Faculty Development Programs in these colleges. This Short Term Course (Formerly known as FDP) is being organized as part of these programs that are to be covered in accordance to this MoA.

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The Programme comprises of:

- Methodology of group discussions and role-playing to inculcate life-skills.
- Talks and Presentations to bring out attitudinal and behavioral changes.
- Breathing techniques (like the world-renowned and well-researched Sudarshan Kriya) to flush out stresses and toxins.
- Aspects of Asanas and Pranayama to increase concentration and clarity of mind.

PAYMENT: Non-Refundable Fees of Rs 2500 (Refundable, ONLY if not accommodated)


